# **Programmatic Overview**

#### **Education Initiatives**



HOPE Foundation's education initiatives focus on providing quality education to children in underserved communities. In 2023–24, we expanded our Atal Tinkering Labs program, reaching over 16,000 students across four states. These labs provide a hands-on learning environment where students can explore STEM subjects and develop critical thinking skills. Additionally, we introduced digital literacy programs for students in rural areas, equipping them with the skills they need to succeed in an increasingly digital world.



The Samsung School of Chinnangudi remains a beacon of academic excellence, offering holistic development, academic engagement, and a sense of community through activities like Republic Day celebrations. Student case studies like Vithisha and Ananya showcase the power of supportive education in transforming lives.



The Cradle to Career initiative aims to provide educational and vocational skills to individuals at various stages of life, emphasizing technical, extracurricular, and employable skills.















# STEM Lab Implementation Project (2023-24)

#### Overview

The STEM Lab Implementation Project, supported by AQuity Solutions India Private Limited, introduced advanced STEM labs in four schools across two locations: Mohali (Punjab) and Vizag (Andhra Pradesh). The initiative aimed to improve science and math learning outcomes for students in grades 5 to 10 by enhancing infrastructure, equipping schools with modern resources, and empowering teachers through professional training.





The STEM Lab implementation for the academic year 2023–24 has laid a robust foundation for science and math education in Mohali and Vizag. With upgraded infrastructure, enriched resources, and empowered educators, the project has the potential to drive long-term improvements in educational outcomes, benefiting both students and their communities.















# Skilling and Livelihood Programs

Ourskillingand livelihoodprogramsaimto empowerindividualswiththeskills they needto secure sustainable employment. This year, we trained over 5,000 individuals inAI-Python, digital literacy, and vocational skills such as tailoring and retail management. Our job placement programs saw an 80% success rate, with over 200 individuals securing jobs in sectors like hospitality, healthcare, and retail. We also launched an entrepreneurship development program, providing women and youth with the tools and mentorship they need to start their own businesses.

#### The Endurance Centre of Vocational Empowerment (ECOVE)

A collaboration between Sevak Trust, Endurance Manufacturing CSR wing, and HOPE Foundation, offers vocational training for school dropouts, economically disadvantaged youth, and unemployed individuals in Aurangabad's industrial zones.

#### Livelihood and Employability for Displaced Tribals



Location: Navi, Dapchari, Kosbad, District Palghar, Maharashtra 401403



Goal: Empower 3,500 individuals

This 3-5 year project aims to transform agriculture in Palghar through sustainable practices such as organic farming, crop rotation, zero pesticide usage, improved irrigation, and mulching. Saplings of mango, jackfruit, bamboo, and cashew nut will be planted to enhance income and biodiversity, empowering displaced tribal communities with sustainable livelihoods.



#### **Healthcare Services**

HOPE Foundation's healthcare services continued to expand in 2023–24, reaching over 50,000 beneficiaries through mobile clinics, health camps, and mental health counseling services. Our focus this year was on maternal and child health, mental health, and community healthcare outreach. We partnered with local governments to provide free healthcare services in rural areas, ensuring that underserved populations had access to essential medical care.

#### Cancer Awareness Day program:



On November 7, 2023, the Manpower Vocational Training Centre, Hope Foundation Tharangambadi, hosted a Cancer Awareness Day program for its staff and students. Organized collaboratively by the staff and students, the event aimed to educate participants about cancer prevention, early detection, and treatment.



The program featured two main activities: a special tips session and an engaging quiz game. Mr. Hariharen, the centre's field executive, led the special tips session, offering valuable advice on reducing cancer risk. He emphasized lifestyle changes such as avoiding tobacco, alcohol, and processed foods, maintaining a healthy weight, staying physically active, and scheduling regular screenings. Additionally, he outlined common signs and symptoms of cancer, urging attendees to seek medical attention for any unusual changes in their bodies.
